12 - Month Study Planner

This study planner has been created to help you prepare for the Patent Bar exam within a 12-month time period.

We've broken down the exact activities to do each day of the week for 52 weeks (12 months). This study plan requires the following:

- A commitment of 2 or 3 study days per week, each and every week during the 52 week period.

Re-take the quiz until you score 70% or above if possible. Note that short answer quizzes are not scored, but you'll want to make sure you understand the answers to each.
