4 - Week Study Planner

This study planner has been created to help you prepare for the Patent Bar exam within an 4 week time period.

We've broken down the exact activities to do each day of the week for 4 weeks. This study plan requires the following:

- A commitment of 7 study days per week, each and every week during the 4 week period.
- A commitment of between 30 and 50 hours of study time per week. You may need more or less depending on how quickly you move through the material while still retaining it.

Unfortunately, with only 4-weeks to study, you will need to move through everything faster. It's probable that you will have to skim through chapters without taking as many notes and focus on the quizzes. However, just by searching for the answers to the quizzes you will learn the material and where it is located within the MPEP for exam day look-up. You should spend as much time as possible on the most heavily tested chapters and topics as shown by our 5-star rating system (found within the course). In addition, make sure to spend the most time on the PatExam Engine™ topic exams that are the most heavily tested.

Please note that for tasks that include reviewing the material you will need to review all the training in the module or Guidebook section. Tasks that involve taking quizzes include short answer and fill-in-the-blank, true/false questions. Any and all quizzes available should be taken. Ideally, you'll want to score at least a 70% on each quiz (whether it be a simple quiz in the Basic Patent Training, a true/false, fill-in-the-blank quiz, or a practice exam). Re-take the quiz until

you score 70% or above if possible. Note that short answer quizzes are not scored, but you'll want to make sure you understand the answers to each.

It's best to transfer the schedule included here to a day planner where you can mark the exact dates each activity should be completed by.
